The survey was carried out in Brookfield. 62% of respondents had postcode of 4069 (Kenmore/Brookfield and Pullenvale), whereas only 15% were from 4070 (Moggill and Bellbowrie). It is considered that the answers would probably be different if more had come from Moggill and Bellbowrie.
